Command Sergeant Major Dorsey Newcomb, U.S. Army (ret), earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice Administration in 2000 from Columbia College, Columbia, Missouri and an Associate of Applied Science in Law Enforcement in 1989 from Central Texas College, Bremerhaven, Germany.

CSM Newcomb served as Commandant, Maneuver Support Center Noncommissioned Officer Academy (NCO), Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri from 2005 to 2008. At the NCO Academy, he was responsible for training 5,237 personnel annually through 22 separate curriculums in the largest leadership academy in the United States Army.
