Ms. Lenczowski serves as Executive Director of AmericaView, a not-for-profit consortium comprised of university-led, state-based consortia working together to sustain a network of state and local remote sensing scientists, educators, analysts, and technicians. She is also the sole proprietor of a small business, serving as a geospatial information and geospatial intelligence consultant. She retired with over 28 years of federal service from the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency (NGA) in 2005, as the agency's senior Executive Director of its St. Louis and other West operations. Prior to that, Ms. Lenczowski served as NGA's Technical Executive for three years while in Washington, D.C. She held numerous technical and managerial senior leadership positions in both St. Louis and Washington, DC during her federal career.

In addition to consultancy agreements with other companies, she is currently a Board Member of the non-profit Leonard Wood Institute, and the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA) St Louis Region. In 2013, she completed a term as National President for ASPRS and is currently Board Secretary.

Ms. Lenczowski has served on several national advisory groups and study teams. In the early 1990's, she was an initial member of the Board of Directors of the National Center for Geographic Information and Analysis, a consortium of three universities funded under a National Science Foundation grant to establish and to support the national research agenda for geospatial studies. Before leaving Washington in 2004, she was appointed a member of the Department of Commerce's federal advisory committee (FACA) on commercial remote sensing (ACCRES) and in 2006, completed her term as a member of the Department of Interior's FACA on archiving remotely sensed imagery (NSLRSDA). She served as a board member for the Security Affairs Support Association (now INSA) through June 2005. In 2012, she was appointed to the current NOAA Advisory Committee on Commercial Remote Sensing (ACCRES). She also represents ASPRS at the Coalition of Geospatial Organizations (COGO).

Ms. Lenczowski holds degrees from Creighton University, St Louis University, and Washington University. She is married to Jerome (Jerry) Lenczowski. They are parents to six daughters.
