Michael Dunbar is currently the President and CEO of Security Bank of Pulaski County, as well as an Adjunct Professor at Drury University in St. Robert, Missouri. Mr. Dunbar has also been the Chairman of the Missouri Military Preparedness and Enhancement Commission since 2013, and was awarded the Lieutenant Governor's Veterans Service Award in 2014.

Mr. Dunbar began his career as a Trial Counsel in the U.S. Army's Judge Advocate General Corps at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri in 1983. After four years, he began his civilian sector career as a Partner at Smith & Dunbar Attorneys at Law. In 2002, he transitioned to Security Bank as the General Counsel and Chairman of the Board. He held that position until 2005, when he became the bank's President and CEO.

As an active member of the community, Mr. Dunbar is a member of the Waynesville – St. Robert Chamber of Commerce, where as President from 2012-2014, he led the group to be selected the Missouri Chamber of the Year in 2013.
